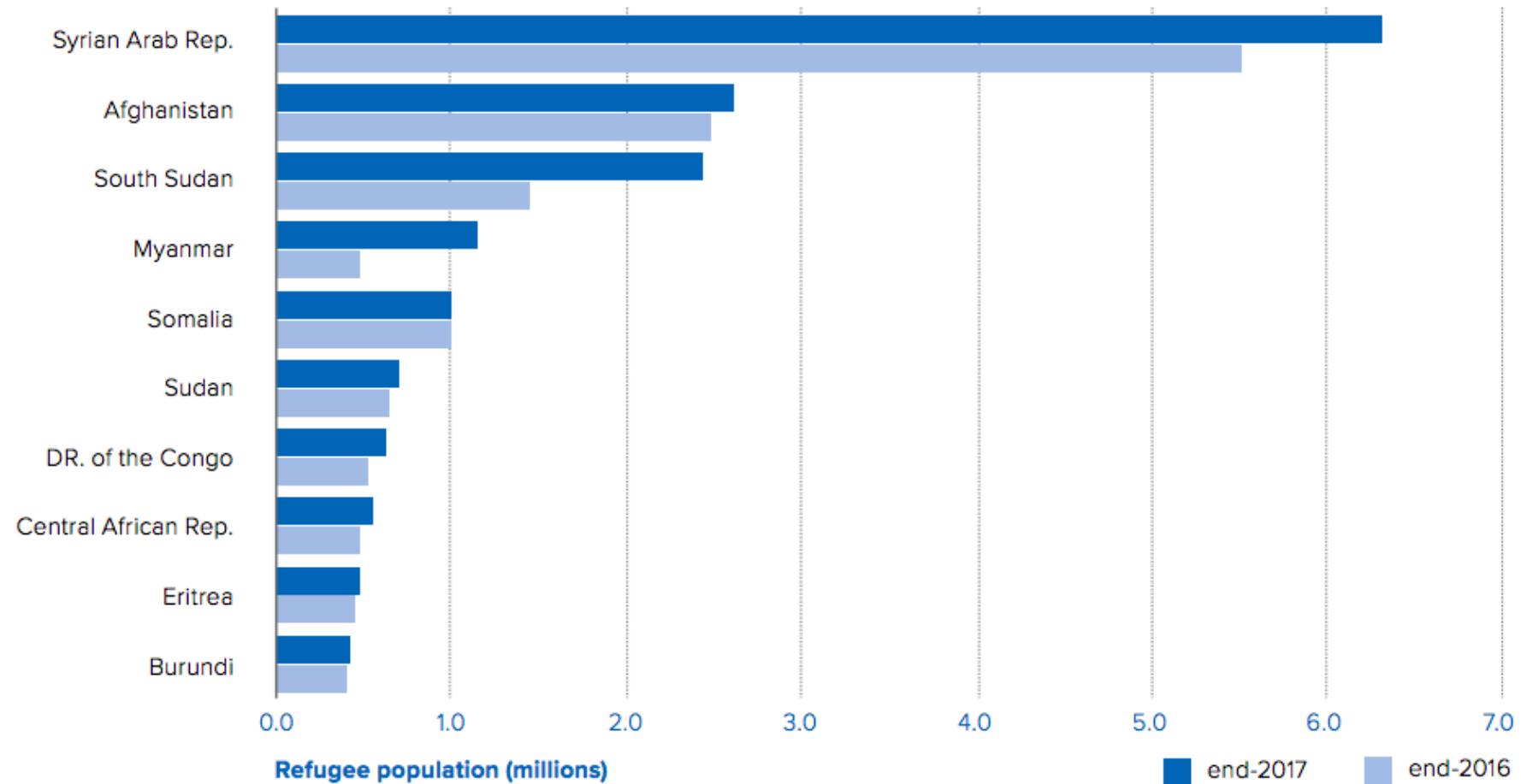

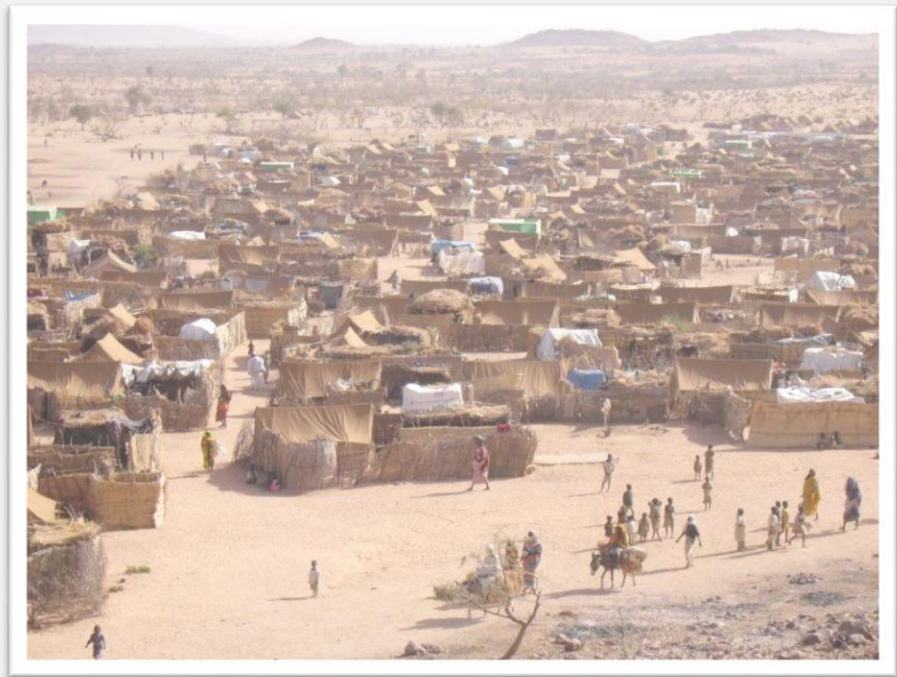
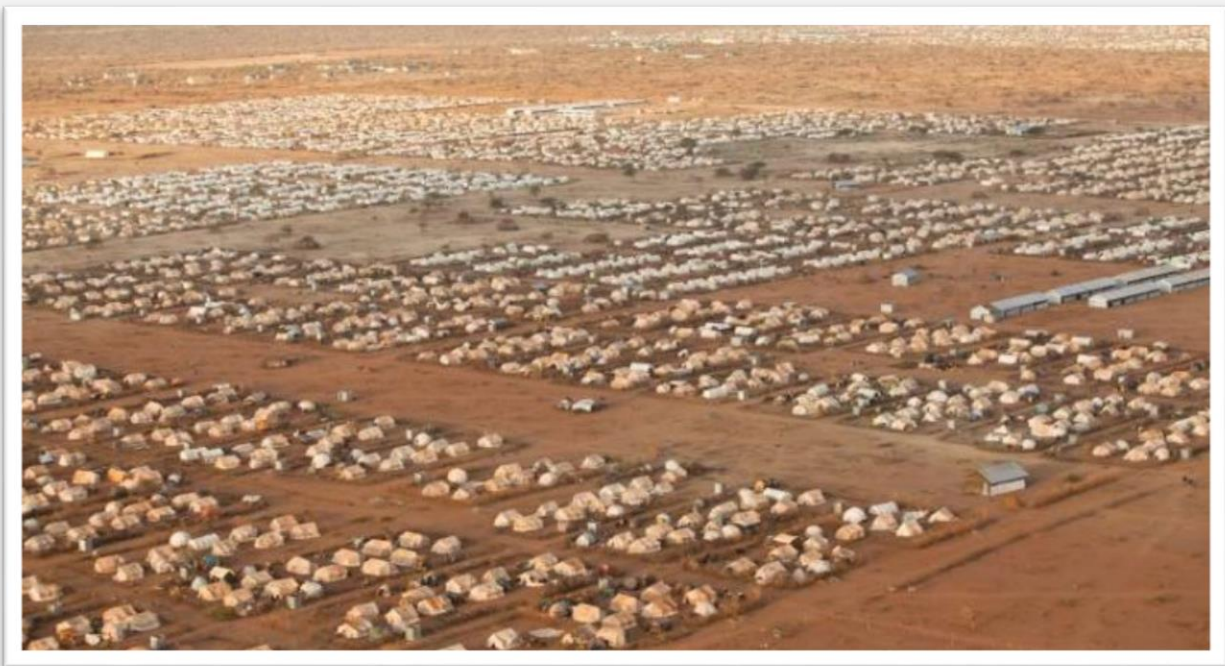

Where does the majority come from?

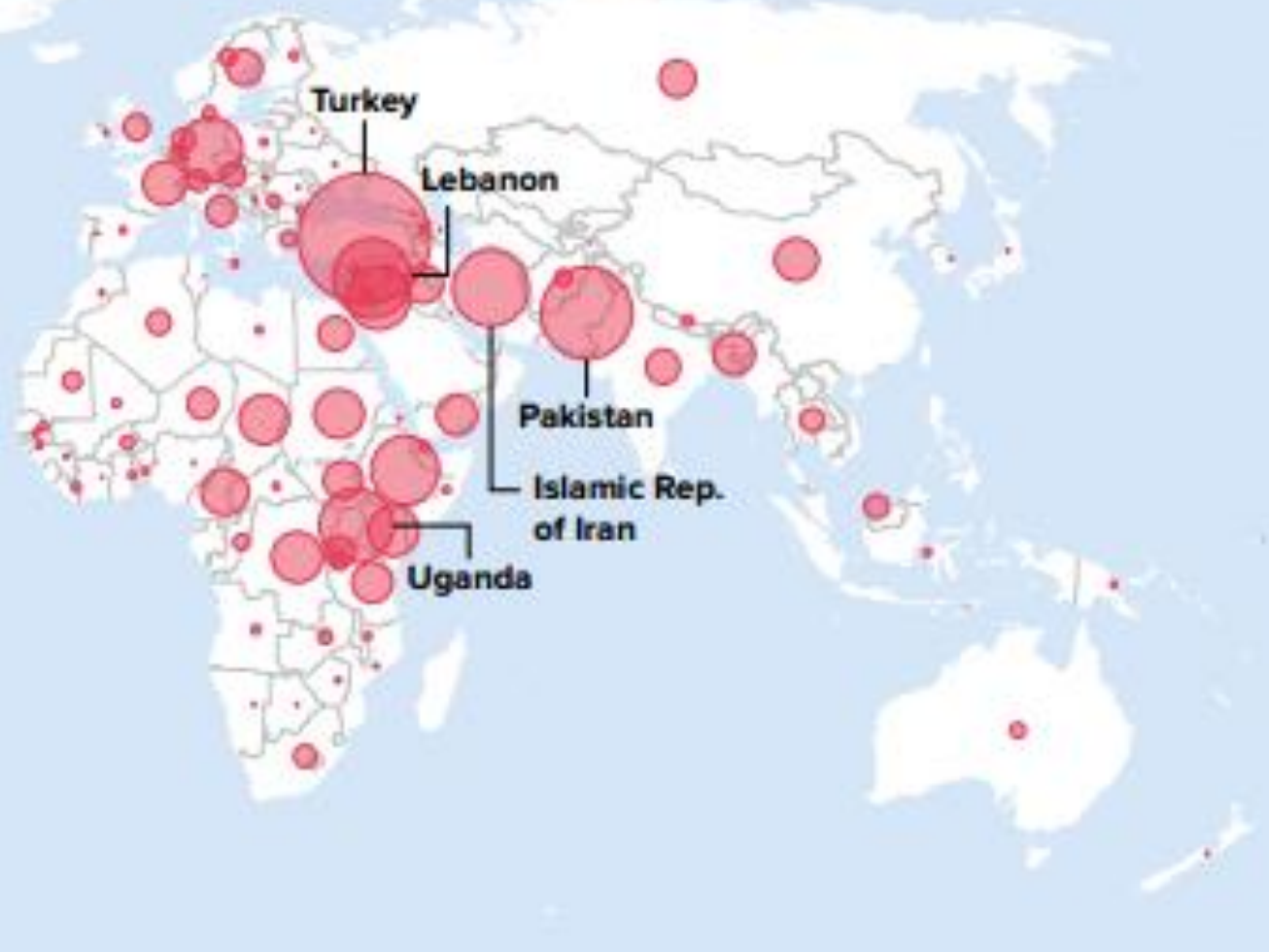
Figure 3 | Major source countries of refugees

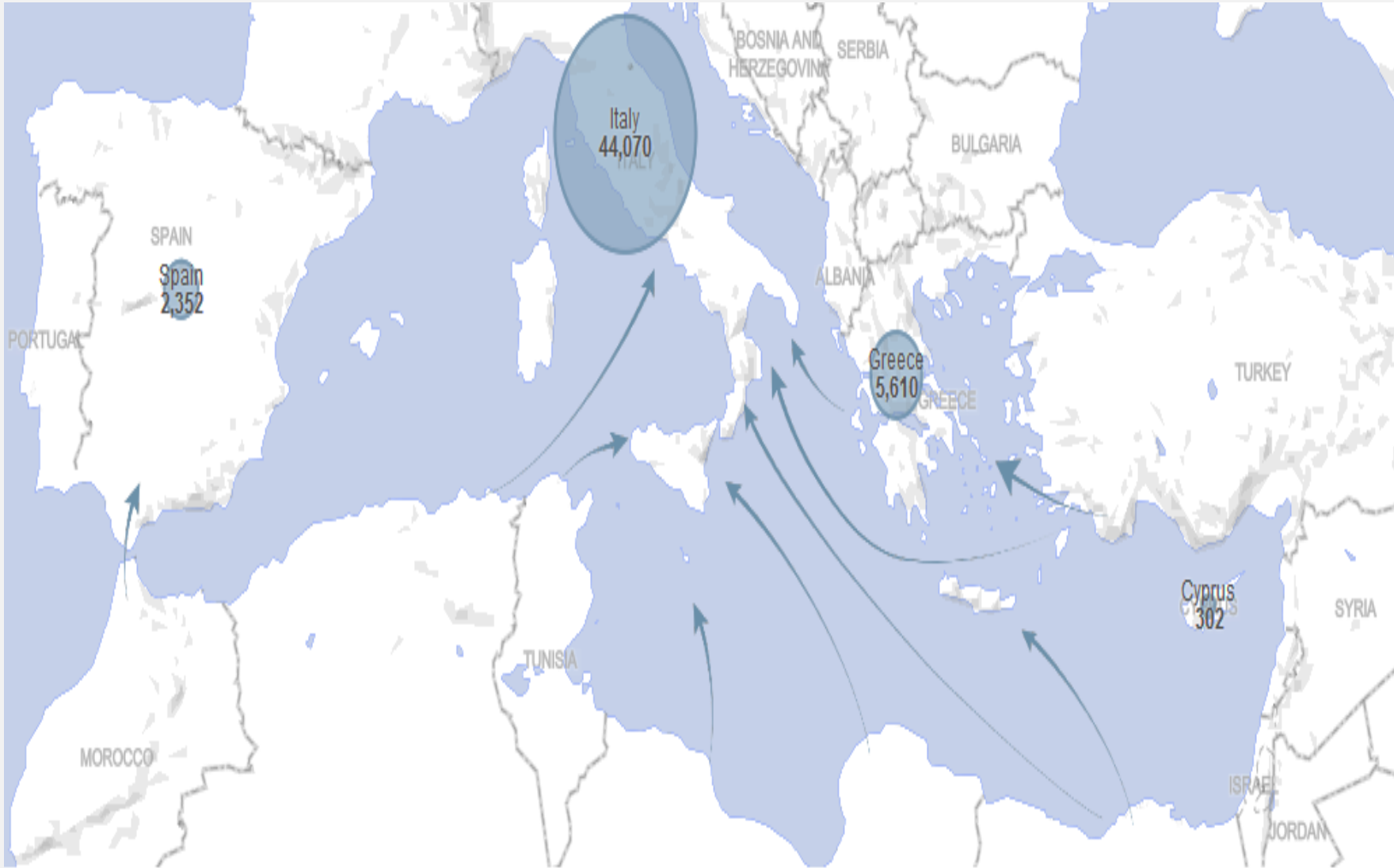

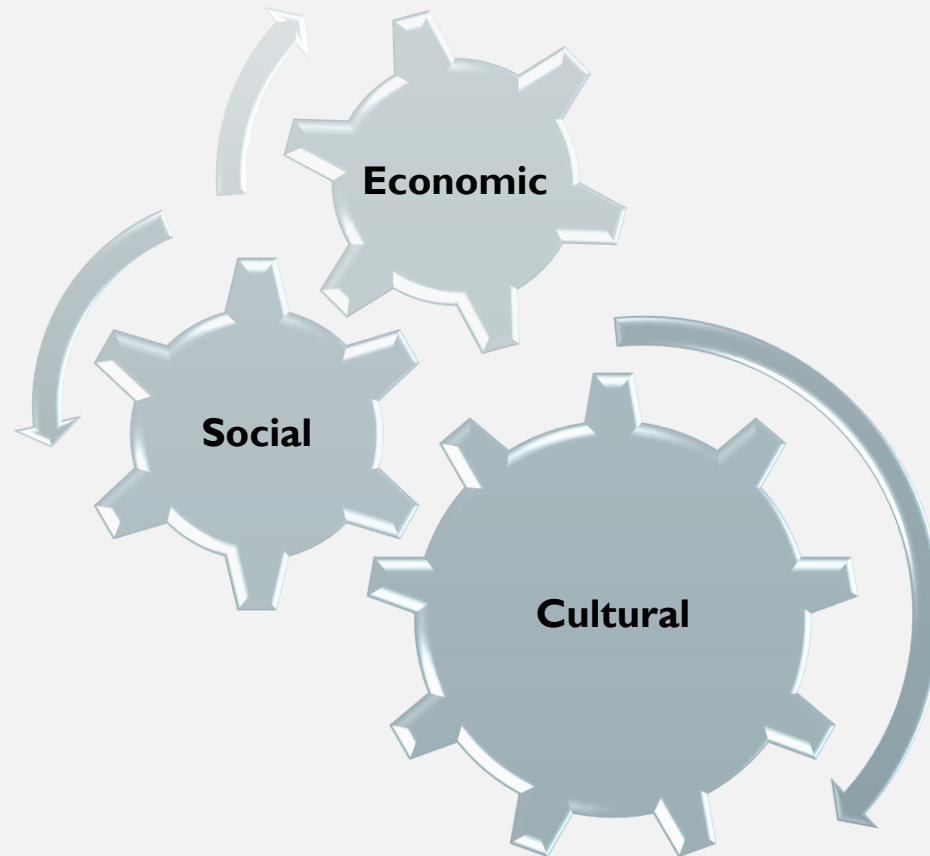
SOME DATAS CONCERNING REFUGEES IN GERMANY
